Baron de Villeboerg Brut, Champagne, France 9.95 / 49.50
pale golden yellow colour with fine, persistent bubbles, it has an elegant nose with notes of blossom and yellow apple, with a fresh palate of pear, apple and citrus

Taittinger Brut Réserve NV, Champagne, France (ve) 13.50 / 77.50
the intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance

Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé, Champagne, France (ve) 82.00
stylish and dry with delicious summer fruit aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour typical of Pinot Noir based Champagnes

Dom Pérignon Brut, Champagne, France (ve) 190.00
long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe; complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years

Verdejo, Ayrum, La Mancha, Spain 5.95 / 7.75 / 21.75
refreshing and crisp with lemon and lime flavours and a soft, round finish

Pinot Grigio IGT (Organic), Vinuva, Terre Siciliane, Italy (ve) 8.50 / 11.00 / 32.00
light, delicately-flavoured, refreshingly dry with hints of apple

Vinho Verde, Esporão, Bico Amarelo, Minho, Portugal (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
rich strawberry, apple and white peach with a hint of citrus

Picpoul, Gerard Bertrand Heritage, Occitanie, France (ve) 9.30 / 12.05 / 35.00
deliciously fresh on the palate with beautiful notes of lemon and an invigorating finish

Gavi di Gavi, Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata, Piemonte, Italy (ve) 39.00
this excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints

Chablis Icauna, Burgundy, France (ve) 46.00
fresh, lively with a citrus and white blossom character backed by a finish tinged with minerality

Juicy & Ripe

Chardonnay, Mount Rozier, Stellenbosch, South Africa (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
riper-style chardonnay with apricots, yellow apples and white peach

Marsanne-Viognier, Élevé, Pays d'Oc, France (ve) 8.75 / 11.35 / 33.00
soft and aromatic with notes of peach blossom and citrus on the deliciously refreshing finish

Monte Velho Branco, Esporão, Alentejo, Portugal (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
citrus notes of lemon and white stone fruit, in a complex and enveloping set

Recommended: Riesling, Ste Michelle Columbia Valley, Washington State, USA (ve) 39.00
crisp apple and white peach flavours with subtle mineral notes, incredibly refreshing and flavourful

Herbaceous & Aromatic

Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Rita 8KM, Central Valley, Chile (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
exuberant citrus and tropical aromas with a creamy texture and refreshing finish

Sauvignon Blanc, Petal & Stem, Marlborough New Zealand (ve) 9.80 / 12.75 / 37.00
classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with elderflower and tropical fruit flavours

Albariño, Yealands Estate Single Vineyard, New Zealand (ve) 38.00
layers of ripe yellow plum, lifted lime blossom and sea spray. The palate is lively with bright acidity and lingering minerality

Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, Loire, France (ve) 49.00
stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, with a clean finish – from one of the finest and most dynamic producers

Full-flavoured & Oaked

Chenin Blanc, Kleine Zalze, Stellenbosch, South Africa 9.55 / 12.40 / 36.00
ripe and silky-smooth, from South Africa's most popular white grape variety, with rich guava fruit and honeyed character

Rioja Blanco, Barrel Fermented, Viña Real, Rioja, Spain (ve) 37.50
beautifully balanced and quite delicious with pure, floral and citrus aromas leading into a rounded, creamy, rich palate

Chardonnay, Ste Michelle Columbia Valley, Washington State, USA (ve) 47.00
a fresh, soft style with bright apple and sweet citrus fruit character with subtle spice and oak nuances

Muscat, Torres Natureo, Catalunya, Spain 7.40 / 9.70 / 28.50
green apples, peaches and citrus, bright and refreshing finish – very sophisticated flavours 0.5% ABV

Simple & Delicate

Tempranillo, Ayrum, La Mancha, Spain 5.75 / 7.50 / 21.75
deep, dark purple appearance with rich plums and structured tannins

Grenache-Merlot, Crusan, Pays d'Oc, France (ve) 8.20 / 10.65 / 31.00
a lovely soft round wine with fresh fruity blackberry and hints of pepper

Pinot Noir, Mount Rozier, Coastal Region, South Africa (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
a purple tint on the rim with delicious flavours of ripe strawberry and rich red cherry

Beaujolais-Villages Pascal Clément, Burgundy, France (ve) 37.00
ruby-red in colour, with aromas of red berries on the nose, it has a refreshingly light and soft palate with fresh, red fruit on the finish

Spicy & Peppery

Shiraz, Berri Estates, South Eastern Australia 8.50 / 11.00 / 32.00
warming blackcurrant and bramble fruit

Malbec, Zarapito, Mendoza, Argentina (v) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
delicious aromas of ripe dark berry fruit, including raspberry and currant flavours, with notes of sweet spice and a touch of leather – the finish is long and persistent with soft, sweet tannins

Rioja Crianza, Viña Real, Rioja, Spain (ve) 10.05 / 13.05 / 38.00
rich aromas of fruit cake and spice with a rounded silky texture and smooth tannins

Primitivo del Manduria, Gocce, Feudi Salentini, Puglia, Italy 49.00
wild berries and notes of caramel, smooth with some spicy, aromatic notes

Cabernet Sauvignon, Journey's End, Stellenbosch, South Africa (ve) 47.50
mouth-filling blackcurrants and cherries with a gentle vanilla-spice finish

Medium-Bodied & Smooth

Tempranillo-Shiraz, Casa Albali, Valdepeñas, Spain 7.80 / 10.15 / 29.50
plenty of ripe cherry and plum fruit flavours, smooth finish

Merlot, Santa Rita 8KM, Central Valley, Chile (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
Fruit-driven, raspberry and blueberry fruit leading to a soft finish

Monte Velho Tinto, Esporão, Alentejo, Portugal (ve) 9.30 / 12.05 / 35.00
black fruit and wild berries with intense rich finish

Pinot Noir Reserve, Vidal, Marlborough, New Zealand 44.00
raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique ageing

Oaked & Concentrated

Fiorebella Rosso Appassimento, Veneto, Italy (ve) 9.00 / 11.70 / 34.00
intense ruby-red, with a bouquet reminiscent of cherry, dried fruit, chocolate and prune; the palate is full-bodied, soft and round, with a spiciness and lingering finish

Shiraz Mourvèdre, Journey's End, Stellenbosch, South Africa (ve) 9.80 / 12.75 / 37.00
medium-bodied with a deep ruby colour, this is a generous and fruity wine with aromas and flavours of forest fruits, cassis and blackberries

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Château des Bardes, Bordeaux, France 60.00
the wine has rich, fruit aromas; juicy, sweet tannins backed by soft touches of vanilla-toastiness from time spent in oak

Shiraz, St Hallett Blackwell, Barossa Valley, Australia 67.00
an intense long finish with powerful aromas of blackberry, cocoa and nutmeg

Sophisticated & Complex

Malbec, Zuccardi Serie A, Uco Valley, Argentina (ve) 48.00
ripe red fruit aromas of prunes and cherries with black pepper and tobacco

Recommended: Syrah, Ste Michelle Columbia Valley, Washington State, USA (v) 50.00
an approachable and fruit-forward style, bright and juicy with ripe berry and hints of vanilla, this Syrah pairs exceptionally well with BBQ ribs, grilled meat and hard cheeses

Côte de Beaune-Villages, Réserve des Jacobins, Louis Jadot, Burgundy, France (ve) 62.00
a more feminine and certainly seductive style – cherry blossom aromas mingle with gentle hints of spiced barrique

Rioja Reserva, Contino, Rioja, Spain (ve) 66.00
ruby-red, very fruity with an intense nose showing strawberry, blueberry, vanilla and a balsamic finish; the palate is round, velvety and mouth-filling

Barolo, Enrico Serafino, Piemonte, Italy (ve) 72.00
big, well-structured red, intensely elegant nose, with red fruit, vanilla and spicy notes of liquorice

Low Alcohol

Syrah, Torres Natureo, Catalunya, Spain 7.40 / 9.70 / 28.50
shows lovely, lively hedgerow fruit on a well balanced and juicy palate 0.5% ABV

Rosé

Pinot Grigio Rosato, Antonio Rubini, Venezia, Italy (ve) 8.50 / 11.00 / 32.00
a delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas and flavours

White Zinfandel, Riptide, California, USA 8.75 / 11.35 / 33.00
strawberry and sweet red fruit flavours balanced by a zesty clean finish

Recommended: Côtes de Provence, Minuty M, Provence, France 10.85 / 14.10 / 41.00
crisp, vibrant bouquet, light and intense flavour, delicious aromas of orange peel and currant, supple to taste, with a nice sharp freshness
